Work with your group to complete the following tasks and prepare to present your project to the class.

- 3. Create a soundtrack of at least 5 songs (commercial or original) that fit your production. Explain how each song fits your vision for your production. You should have at least ONE paragraph per song.
- 4. Use the 1949 newspaper review to write a review of your own production. Include critiques as well as praise.
